- **What You're Looking At** **SPECIALIZED S-WORKS ENDURO SL \$7,700** (PRICE PER GRAM: \$0.63)
- **Why** If you've ever dreamed of owning a mountain bike that climbs like an efficient short-travel feather and descends like an all-mountain maniac, your day has come. The S-Works Enduro has a carbon frame and 150mm of the company's own take on suspension, from its lightweight, dual-crown Future Shock e150 SL fork to the integrated stem and AFR shock with Spike valve adjustment. Top-drawer components such as Avid Juicy Ultimate brakes and Specialized Roval Traversée wheels offer all-mountain performance while keeping overall bike weight down to an impressive 26.82 pounds. It may cost more than the car you're driving, but it probably has a nicer ride. *More info at specialized.com*
